Tourist tax – New regulations - Billing

Dear Sir/Madam,

On 6 August 2022, the aforementioned by-law was presented to second homeowners. Following this presentation, it was approved by the Primary Assembly on 16 November 2022 and ratified by the Cantonal Government of Valais on 1 March 2023. These regulations can be accessed on our website: www.chamoson.ch/taxes

Please find attached the invoice drawn up in accordance with these regulations, i.e. based on the number of rooms in the accommodation.

The number of rooms has been determined based on the information in our possession and in accordance with the guidelines of the Federal Register of Buildings and Dwellings (RegBel).

“The following are considered to be rooms: living rooms, bedrooms, children's rooms, etc., with a surface area of at least 4 m² and a height between the floor and the majority of the ceiling surface of at least 2 m, comprising the living unit within the dwelling. Independent living quarters located outside the dwelling are not counted in the number of rooms. Kitchens, kitchenettes, bathrooms, toilets, storerooms, corridors, verandas, etc. are also not counted as rooms in the dwelling. Half-rooms are not taken into account”.

If the number of rooms does not correspond to your expectations, please inform us within 30 days and we will correct the invoice, if necessary.
